These issues are open:

FRS Suite Manager release version 1.0.0.107

- [M3125] Semicolon in trait name will cause problems with MS Excel standard import. Recommend not to use semicolon in trait name.
- [M3129] CSV export file headers do not match. Repetitive traits naming combines the trait name with the system date. Suite Manager exports the repetitive trait name with four year places. Ex: '07/20/2010'. FRS Mobile exports the repetitive trait name with two year places. Ex: '07/20/10'.

FRS Mobile software release version 3.0.0.174

- [M3112] Last column header in List view hard to expand.
- [M3160] User is unable to add a repetitive trait while in collection mode. Add traits before entering collection.
- [M3161] User should not start two instances of FRS Mobile.
